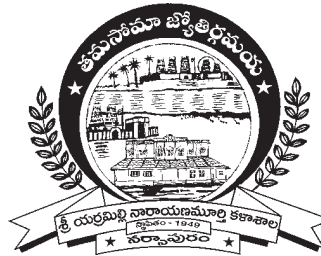

OUR COLLEGE

sri Y.N college was established in the year 1949 on banks of vasista Godavari in a serene atmosphere ideally situated for the pursuit of higher education. The college was started initially in 150 years old Taylor high school premises. It attained the status of Degree college in 1956 and shifted to the present premises of 15 acres land with a dutch building (constructed in 17th century) the present main building of college. The college is elevated to post graduate level in the year 1980-90.

Tuning to the changing needs of the youth in higher education restructured and vocational courses like Electronics , Fisheries, Computer Science, Biotechnology, Microbiology , Biochemistry at degree level and vocational courses at Intermediate level are introduced. The college is elevated to P.G. Level in 1989-90, and initially started M.Com., M.A. English , M.A. Pub-Admn. subsequently M.B.A. (1991-92) M.C.A (1992-93), M.A./M.Sc (Maths) (1995-96), M.Sc (Electronics (1996-97) M.Sc Computers (1999-2000), M.Sc Microbiology (2005-2006) and M.Sc. Bio-technology (2006-2007) were started. At present, the college offers 9 post Graduate courses. The college has a student strength of around 3,000.

I am proud to say that the College, apart from being an institution of teaching has also become a Research Centre since the last academic year. The Andhra University, has recognized the College as a Research Centre and accorded permission to the P.G. Dept. of Public Administration to guide part-time research scholars.

In 2004, the college was accredited with "A" grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation council (NAAC). The college has attained the Autonomous status from the year 2007-2008. The college is offering career Oriented courses sponsored by U.G.C. and job oriented Ad-on courses (evening courses in addition to regular curriculum) for the benefit of the students.

The college has adequate infrastructure in the form of impressive buildings, well equipped laboratories and separate U.G. and P.G. Libraries. The college has good support services to the students like good play ground , gymnasium, N.C.C., N.S.S., community service center , yoga center and career Guidance and placement cell. The college has women's Hostel (U.G.C. Project) in the campus.

The college has competent faculty with a good number of Doctorates, M.Phil's, there is research activity, and it has vibrant academic atmosphere. Some of the faculty members are working in the U.G.C. sponsored Gandhian studies' center.

Over the years the college has produced many outstanding Alumni spread all over world occupying higher positions both in India and Abroad. There is Alumni support for the college development.

With the valuable guidance, support, assistance and rendered by Andhra University, UGC and Education Authorities, the college has evolved as a premier Institute of Higher Education in Andhra University area.

COURSES OFFERED AND STUDENT STRENGTH

The college is offering 09 P.G Courses such as MBA, MCA, MSc (Microbiology, Biotechnology), M.A/ M.Sc (Maths), MSc (Computers), M.Sc (Electronics), M.Com, MA (English) and MA (Pub-Admn) and at degree level Electronics, Fisheries, Computer Science, Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Industrial Relations and Foreign Trade Practices and Procedures besides traditional courses in Arts, Science and Commerce. The present student strength of the college is U.G = 1733, P.G = 680. Total = 2413

FACULTY :

The college has a very competent and experienced faculty. The college has 24 Ph.D's and 26 M.Phil's holders among its faculty. A good number of staff are upgrading their qualifications by doing M.Phil's and Ph.D's. Some of the faculty members have been doing UGC Research Projects, conducting U.G.C sponsored and other seminars and conferences.

The College is having well equipped and spacious Science laboratories separately for UG and PG. For UG there are Physics, Chemistry, Electronics , Computer Science, Zoology, Fisheries, Botany, Biotechnology, Micro Biology , Biochemistry and Geography labs. For PG there are four Computer labs and one Electronics lab. A botanical garden with rare specimens and other flora is another treasure of the institution.

The College is having separate Computerised libraries for UG and PG holding a range of valuable books, journals and periodicals in stock. It has a set of Encyclopedia besides a number of scripts dated decades ago. There is a good collection of books. A good and well furnished reading rooms are also provided adjacent to the libraries for the benefit of the students.

The College is having a furnished auditorium, an open air theatre and a seminar hall to organize Guest lectures, Symposia, Seminars and College literary and cultural programs. There is a well furnished Guest Room for the College.

The College has spacious playground with courts for different games. An indoor shuttle/ Badminton court, multi-gym, sports equipment and games equipment to get the physical education activity of the students.

There are about 294 Computer systems in the College with adequate number of printing devices and Reprography facilities. There are slide projectors, overhead projectors and other audio visual equipment and LCD monitor with projector in the College. All systems are provided with internet facility. There are separate offices and waiting rooms for girls for Intermediate, Degree and PG. Drinking water supply is provided with water coolers at different points. There is a canteen for the students and staff. There are generators for the College to meet the power failure.

NSS

Our College has two NSS Units comprising 100 members each. The two units are actively involved in clean and green programme, relief camps for flood victims, blood donation camps, awareness programs on

Chikun Gunya, Dengue, Malaria and AIDS. Clean and Green programs were conducted once in a month in and around Narsapur. In our campus cleaning and greening was done 8th-11th Aug 2006 as a special drive. Blood donation camp was organized on 26th Oct. 2006, in which 104 members donated blood. World Aids day was organized with a big rally and distribution of pamphlets on December 1st. Our NSS volunteers were actively engaged in all important functions like International Literacy day, NSS Day , Gandhi Jayanthi, College Anniversary etc.

GANDHIAN STUDIES CENTRE

Gandhian Studies Centre was sanctioned by the UGC, New Delhi during 2006 - 2007 under the Xth Plan. Ours is the first affiliated college having this unique opportunity in Andhra Pradesh. It is a prestigious centre of our college with a view to perpetuate the idea and philosophy of Mahatma Gandhi. The objective of the centre is to promote, organize and undertake the study of life and thought of Mahatma Gandhi and to the study and dissemination of Gandhian thought. To promote activities both for the younger generation and for the more mature Gandhian activities and workers, and to translate the same into social life for the benefit of the Nation.

ACTIVITIES OF THE CENTRE

The centre is maintaining CDs and Films on Gandhi which are distributed by Publications Division, Gandhi Films foundation and so on. We hope that in future this centre will become Documentation and Research Centre on Gandhiji.

With a view to perpetuate the ideas and thought of Mahatma Gandhi, the centre has been organizing, quiz, essay writing elocution and debate competitions on Gandhi from Grade 7th students to post Graduate students in and around Narsapur town on various occasions.

On the occasion of the Gandhiji death anniversary on 31-01-2007, we conducted photo exhibition in a remote village called Turputallu.

National Seminar on Urban and Rural Development was organized on 1st, December, 2006 in our College. Prof. V Bala Mohandas, Vice-Chancellor of Nagarjuna University, Guntur, inaugurated the seminar. Around 200 delegates from all over the state attended and participated in discussions and deliberations on Gandhiji in this seminar. Since its inception, we have been organizing Guest Lectures on Gandhian Ideology and Thought. The Eminent Professors and experts have given lectures on various items and issues related to Gandhian Ideology and its relevance to the present society.

We started a three month Certificate Course in Gandhian Studies for our college students and enrolled 24 students.

VISION OF THE CENTRE

To organize youth camps to counsel the youth about peace and non-violence, to create awareness about how Gandhian Ideology is relevant to the present. We propose to conduct inter-departmental activities in our college to perpetuate Gandhian Ideology through their courses. To publish literature and books on Gandhiji. Part A:

OUTCOME

In October 2006, UGC team consisting of eminent educationist visited our college and after satisfying themselves regarding infrastructural facilities available in college and also overall academic ambience prevailing in the campus recommended conferment of Autonomous to the college. Based on their report UGC recommended conferment status from 2007-2008 to 2012-2013 for a period of five years. Government of Andhra Pradesh also gave it approval. The response of Andhra University for the conferment of Autonomous status is being awaited. Meanwhile senior faculty members in groups went to some reputed Autonomous colleges in AP and Tamilnadu and obtain First hand knowledge about the functioning of the system.

A good number of students got placement in various reputed organizations like Satyam, Wipro, and other Industries.

After obtaining due permission from Govt. of Andhra Pradesh and University M.Sc. Biotechnology is introduced w.e from academic year 2006-2007. State of art Bio technology lab one of the best in Andhra University is established. Competent faculty is recruited.

General level of students in soft skills is increased. Many of the leading firms are evincing interest are conducting campus interviews.

Part B:

- 01** Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution :
Imparting value education to students and make them responsible citizens while increasing employability are major goals and objectives of the Institution. Add on courses, career oriented programmes sponsored by UGC and strong curricular exposure are major activities of the institution. Curricular activities include Seminars, Workshops, Group discussions, Debate, Quiz programmes. Community is stressed inculcate service motto. Cultural events Yoga and health, meditation games and sports aid in the overall development of the students. Acquisition of soft skills were improving employability is also emphasized.
- 02.** New academic programmes Initiated in PG :
M.Sc. Bio technology was started from the current academic year. At UG level 9 POP courses were introduced as evening classes. English practicals in II year, Mathematics practicals in III year were introduced as per the University and APSCHE.
- 03.** Innovation in curricular design and transaction:
Being an affiliated college of Andhra University the college follows the curricula design by the University. However curriculum is strengthened by way of assignment, quiz programme, project work student seminars and guest lectures. Details are given as activities of individual departments.

Many of the add on courses and POP are inter disciplinary in nature. Tourism is a course handled by geography department and Journalism course is handled by Telugu Dept.

18 COMMUNITY SERVICE

Under Community Service Project, the management, the staff and the students of our college organised Godavari Flood Relief Camp at Navarasapuram, YV Lanka and Badava villages which were badly affected during the floods. The biggest event by career guidance and counseling cell is the organization of a two-day workshop on "Career Guidance and Student Counselling and Community Awareness Programmes" on 14th & 15th February, 2007 in collaboration with the Department of Adult and Continuing Education, Andhra University.

One of the milestones for the cell in this academic year is finding placements for 33 Intermediate passed students as trainee operators for Rane Diecase Limited, IDA, Bollaram, Hyderabad.

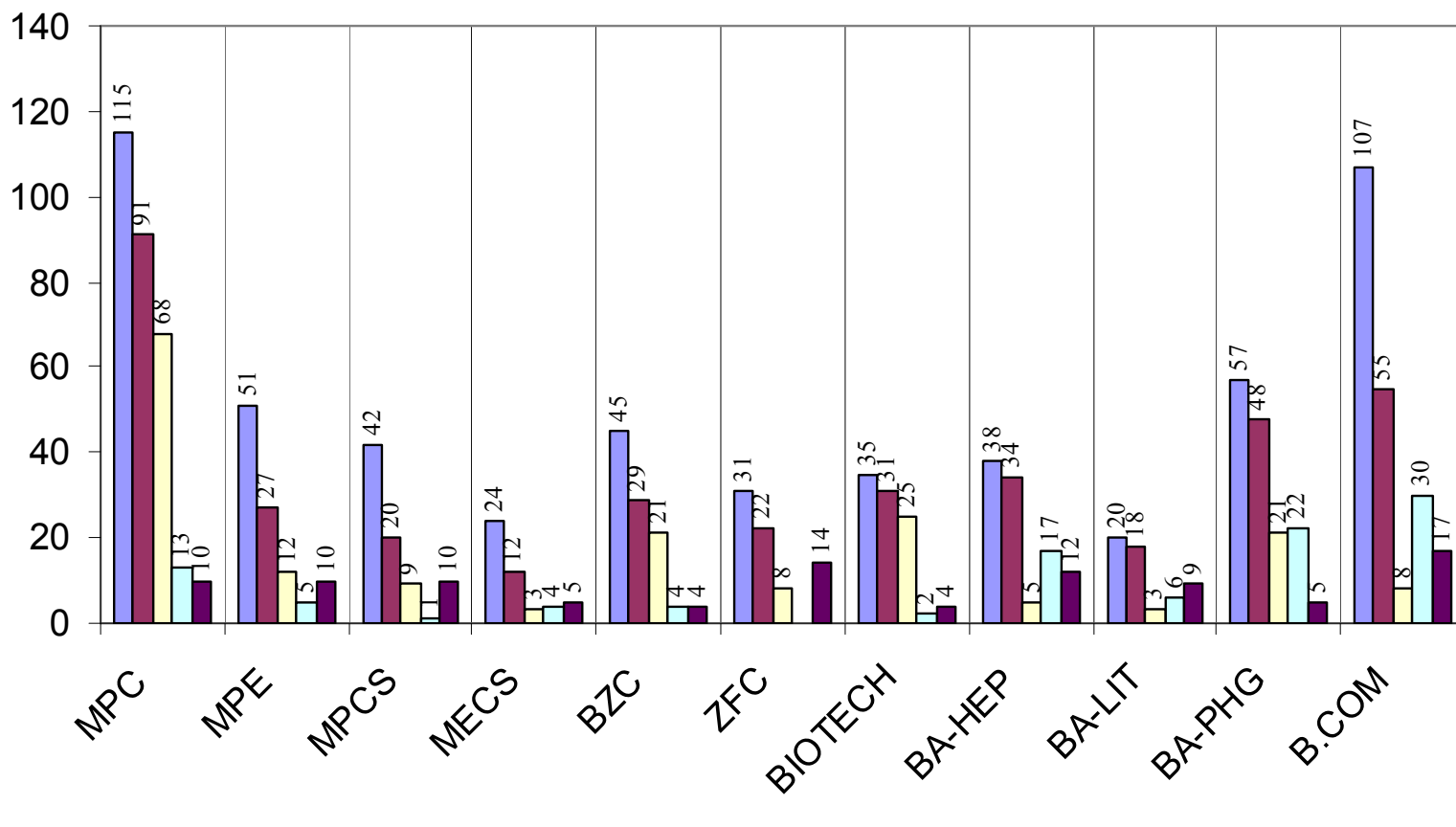
